Methodology

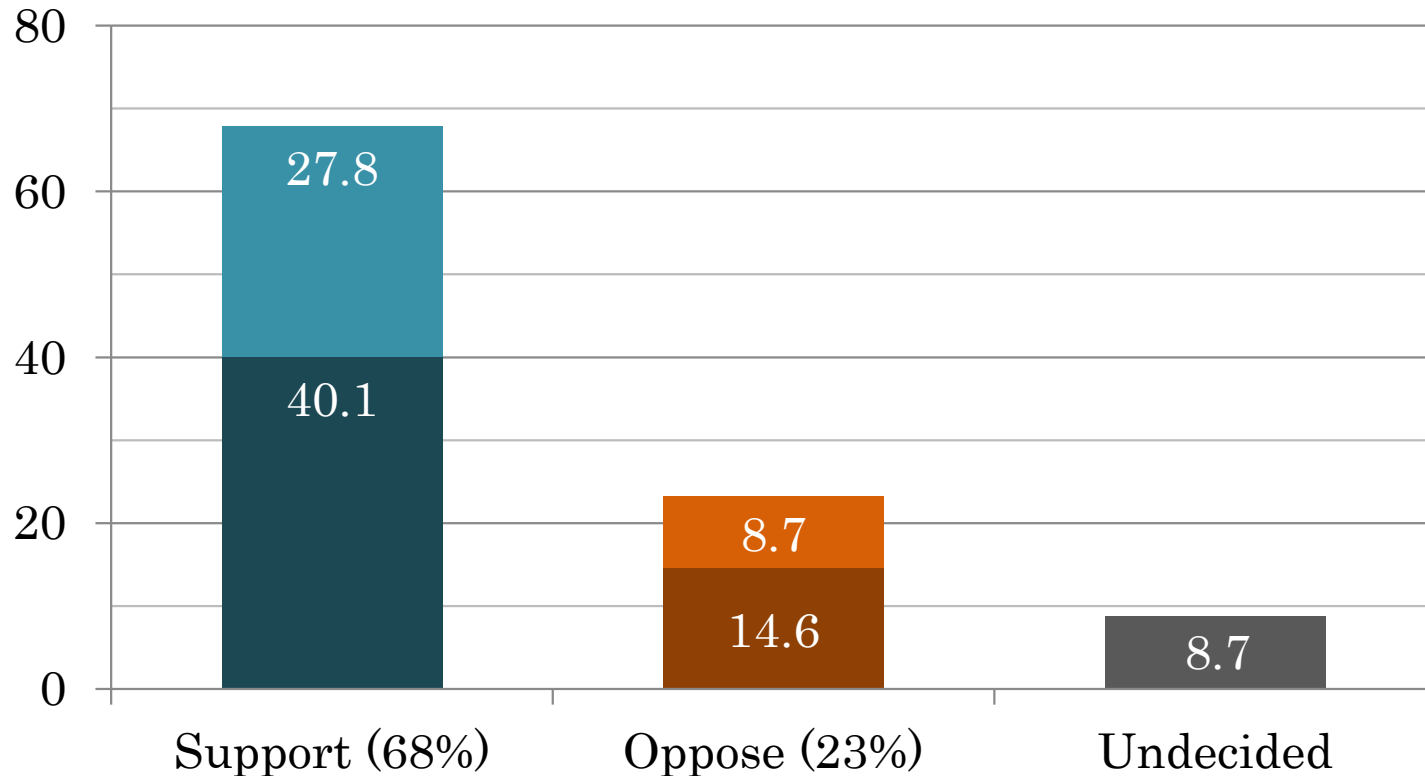
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- A survey of 528 Maine voters was conducted by phone and online in July, 2021.
- Survey results were mathematically weighted by gender, age and geographic area to ensure an accurate representation of the population being surveyed.
- The sample margin of error of this survey is 4.3%, 95 times out of 100. Sub-samples may have a larger margin of error.
- Frequencies and percentages may not always add up to the total number of responses or to 100%, due to weighting and rounding.

Earned path to citizenship

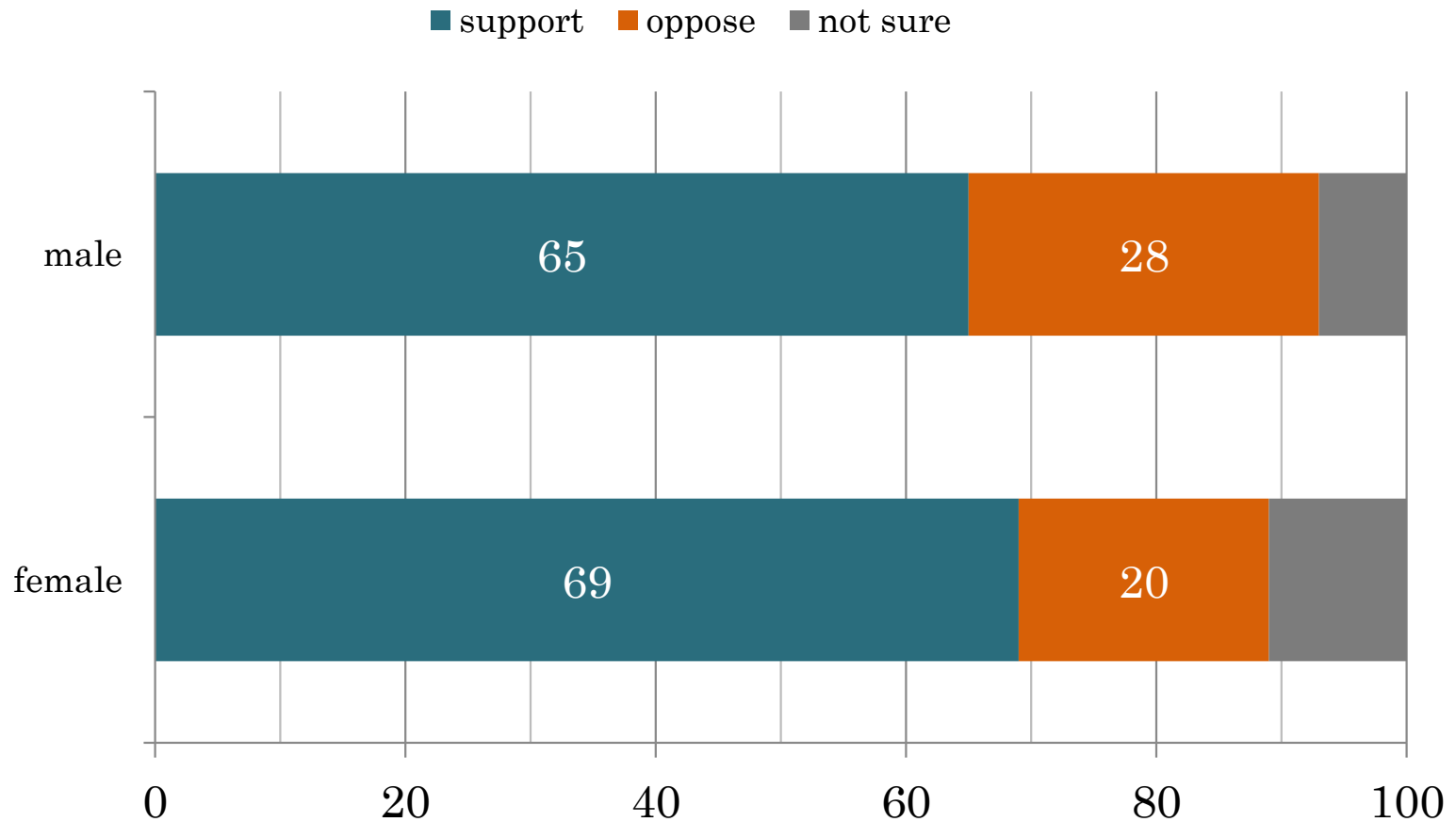

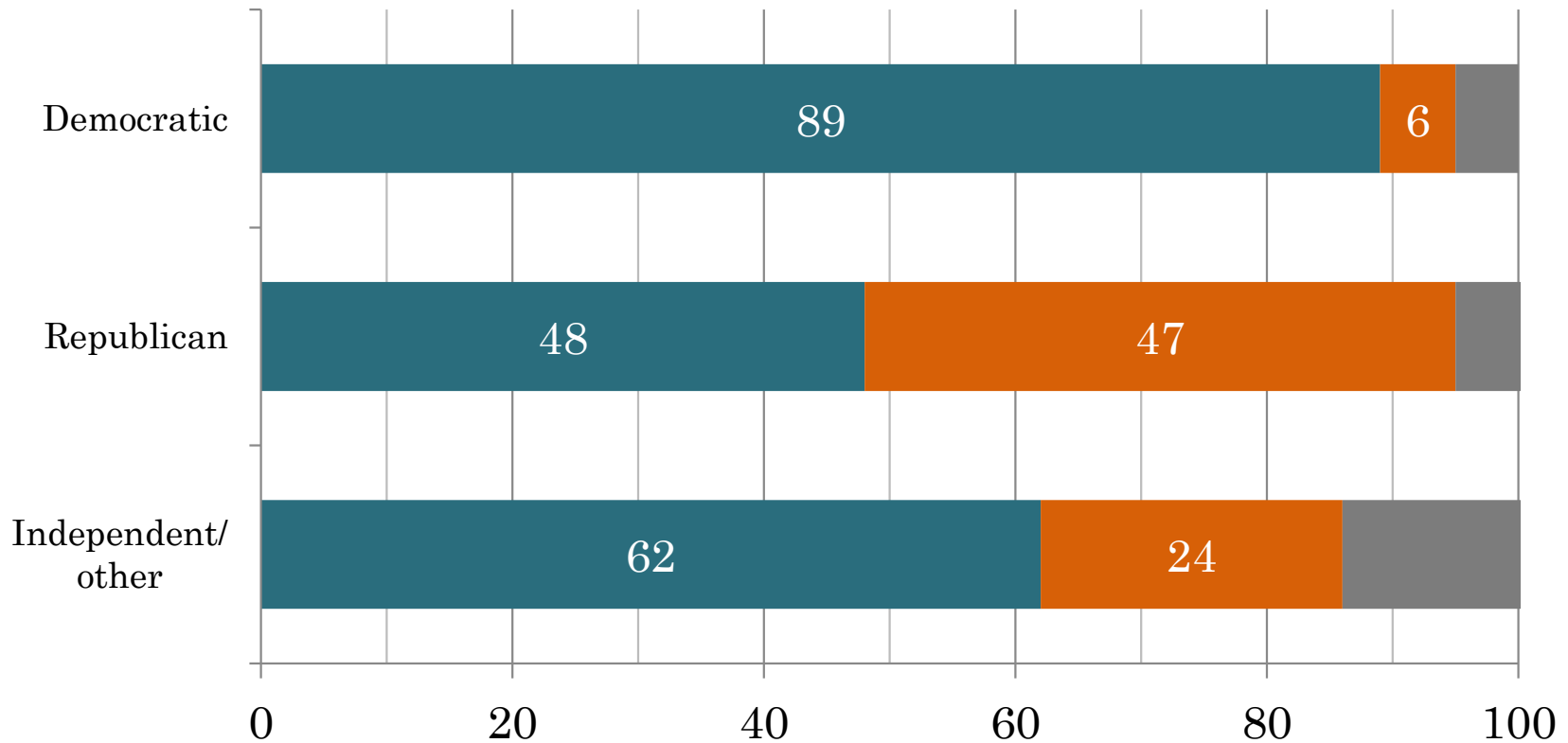


Non-binary gender responses were not at a level that allowed statistical significance.

Immigration by party

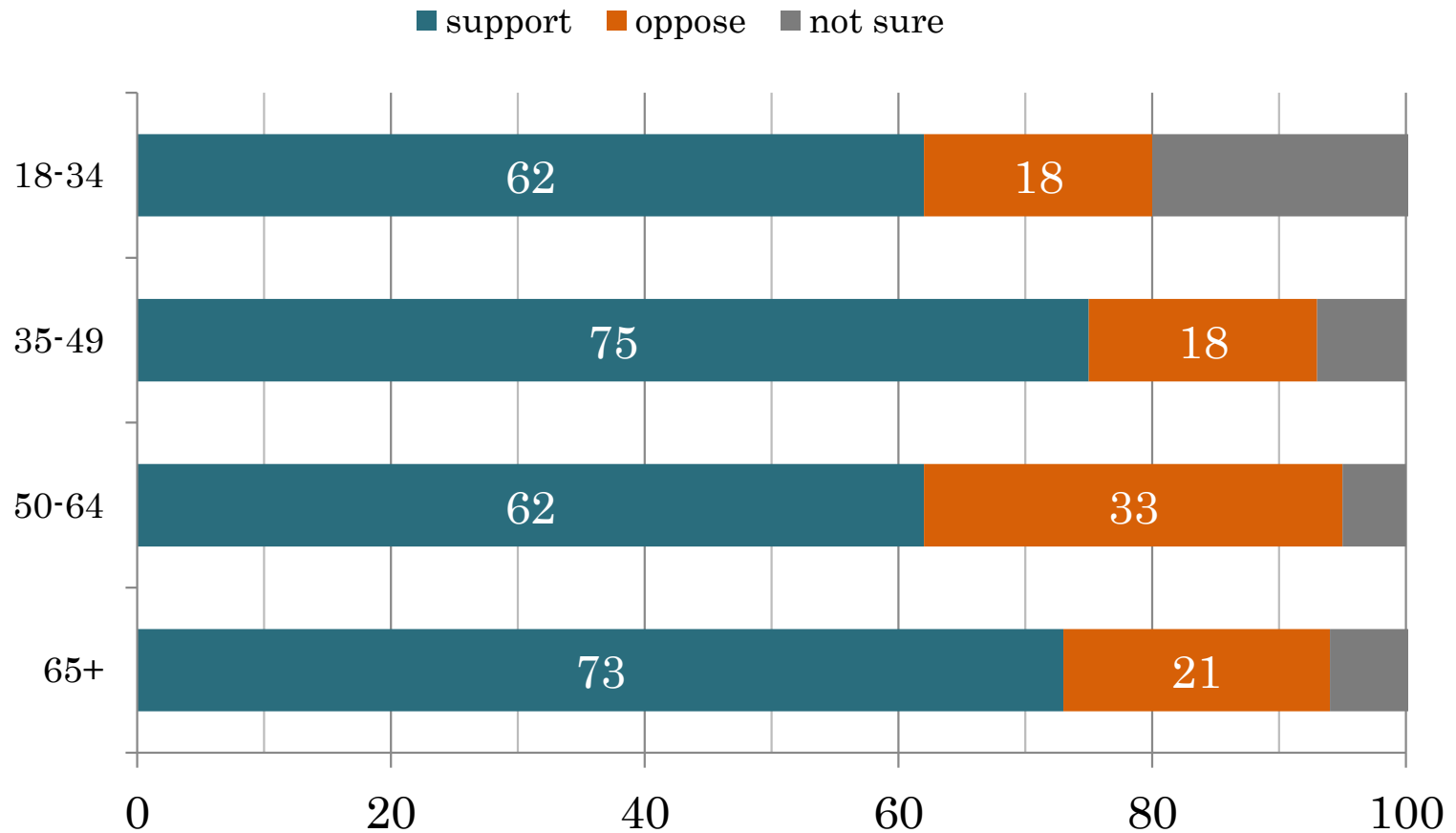
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■ support ■ oppose ■ not sure



Immigration by age

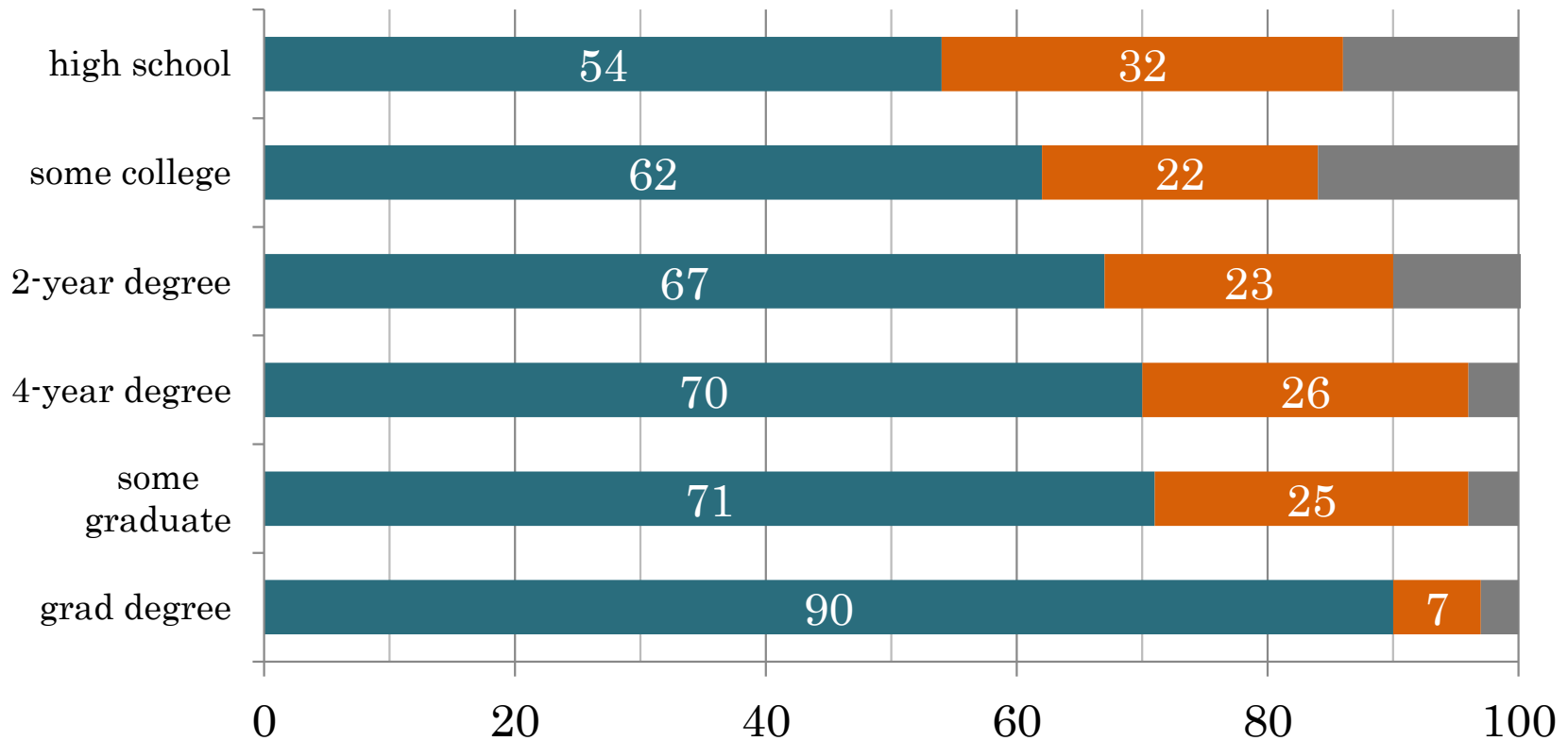
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Immigration by education

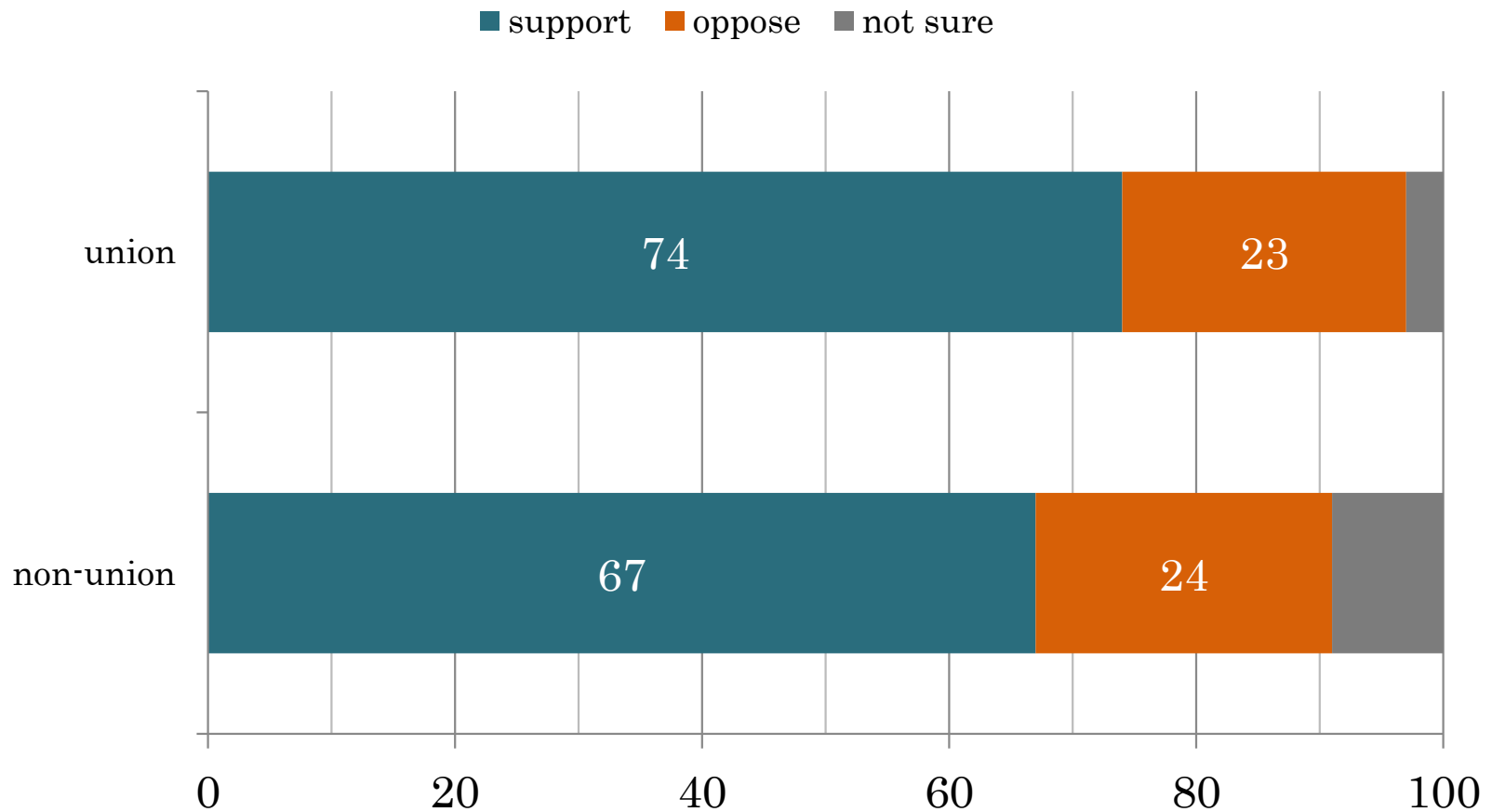

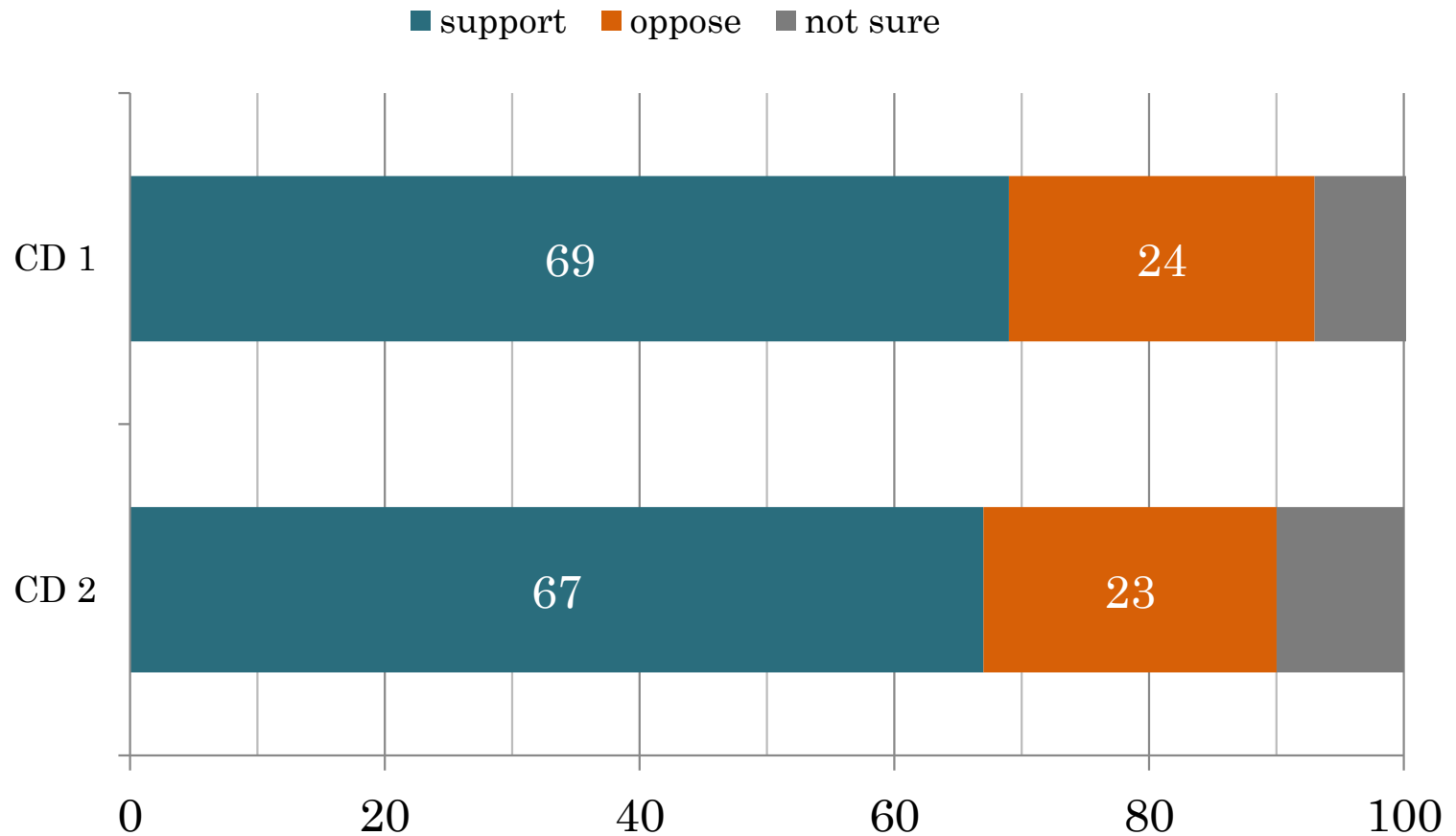
Immigration by union household
